Prayer in the present petition is for quashing of FIR No.134, dated 06.09.2014 under Sections 454, 380 IPC, registered against the petitioner at Police Station, Division No.7 (Vardhman) District Ludhiana City (Annexure P/1) on the basis of compromise (Annexure P-2) alongwith consequential proceedings arising therefrom.

Vide order dated 17.11.2014, this Court had directed the parties to appear before the Illaqa Magistrate on 28.11.2014 to get their statements recorded in support of the compromise. Pursuant to the direction passed by this Court the learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Ludhiana has submitted its report dated 21.02.2015. Learned Magistrate has recorded the statements of the parties and has forwarded a report with the observation that the compromise as entered between the parties is genuine, voluntary and without any threat and coercion.

Learned State counsel does not dispute about the aforesaid facts.

Considering the report of learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class,
Ludhiana that the compromise effected between the parties is genuine FIR
No.134, dated 06.09.2014 under Sections 454, 380 IPC, registered against
the petitioner at Police Station, Division No.7 (Vardhman) District
Ludhiana City is hereby quashed.
