Instant petition has been moved by the petitioners seeking grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No. 106 dated May 24, 2014 under Sections 304-B and 34 IPC registered at Police Station Ajnala, Amritsar Rural, District Amritsar.

It is an undisputed fact that both the petitioners were found innocent during investigation of this case and at the time of presentation of report under Section 173(2) Cr.P.C, their names were mentioned in column No.2 of the report but subsequently, while exercising the jurisdiction under Section 193 Cr.P.C. both the petitioners have been summoned to stand trial alongwith their co-accused.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that in compliance of order dated February 6, 2015, petitioners have already joined the proceedings before learned trial Court and have furnished the requisite bail bonds to its satisfaction. This fact could not be disputed by learned State counsel or ASI Dilbagh Singh, present in Court.

In the given circumstances, custodial interrogation of petitioners is also not required. At the same time, disposal of challan will take sufficient long time.

Accordingly, order dated February 06, 2015 is hereby, made absolute.

Disposed of.

However, petitioners shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
