AJAY TEWARI, J. (Oral)

This is a petition for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.167 dated 08.07.2014, registered under Sections 420, 406, 120-B IPC, at Police Station Sultanwind, District Amritsar City.

On 20.01.2015 the following order was passed:-

“Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Balwinder Singh submits that there is no complaint against the petitioner where as learned counsel appearing for the complainant submits that not only the present complaint but other complaints of similar nature are pending in different Police Stations against the petitioner and he seeks some more time to place on record the same.

One more but last opportunity is granted to do the needful.

Learned counsel for the complainant is directed to place on record complaint, if any, is pending against the petitioner other than the present one.

Adjourned to 02.03.2015.

Interim order to continue.”

Thereafter the case was being repeatedly adjourned for verification of the aforesaid fact. Today learned Addl.AG has clarified that though complaints were filed against the petitioner, the same were investigated and found to be false.

In these circumstances the petition is allowed.

Interim order dated 19.09.2014 is made absolute.

Petition stands disposed of.
