RAJAN GUPTA J.

After arguing at some length, learned counsel for the petitioners submits that he may be allowed to withdraw this petition with liberty to the petitioners to raise all his pleas before the trial court at the appropriate stage. He, however, submits that petitioner no. 2 is mother-in-law of the complainant and is quite old. Thus, her personal appearance may be exempted before the trial court during trial.

Dismissed as withdrawn with aforesaid liberty.

In case any application for exemption from personal appearance is moved by petitioner no. 2, same shall be considered by the trial court in accordance with law. Trial court may consider the exemption of personal appearance of petitioner no. 2 except on the dates it is necessary.
