INDERJIT SINGH, J.

Petitioner has preferred this petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of direction to official respondents not to pressurize her to make a compromise with the private respondents and further not to harass and pressurize her to leave Ludhiana at the instance of private respondents.

Learned counsel for the petitioner only prays for the relief that the representation dated 25.11.2014 (Annexure P-3), moved to Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana, by the petitioner be considered and he does not press the other relief asked in this petition.

In view of above, respondent No.2-the Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana is directed to look into the said representation (Annexure P-3) and pass appropriate order as per law, without being influenced in any way by this order, within two months from the date of receipt of copy of this order.

With aforesaid direction, this petition stands disposed of.
