Petitioner seeks the benefit of regular bail in case F.I.R. No.134 dated 6.9.2013 under Sections 25, 18, 61 of N.D.P.S Act registered at Police Station, Kulgarhi, District Ferozepur.

Learned counsel for the parties have been heard.

Allegations against the petitioner are that he was found in possession of 3 kgs. of opium.

On the previous date of hearing i.e. on 30.1.2015 contention of the counsel for the petitioner had been noticed that even though, the petitioner has been in custody since 6.9.2013 but the trial is not making any headway.

Learned State counsel upon instructions from ASI Kuldeep Singh would apprise the Court that all the prosecution witnesses have since been examined by the Trial Court.

Since the trial has made substantial progress, this Court would not be inclined to entertain the instant petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C.

Petition, accordingly, is dismissed.
