JITENDRA CHAUHAN, J.

The instant petition has been preferred under Section 439 Cr.P.C. seeking regular bail in case FIR No.132 dated 27.12.2014, registered under Sections 307, 148, 149 of the Indian Penal Code and Section 25 of the Arms Act, at Police Station Anandpur Sahib, Distt. Rupnagar.

The learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner is not named in the FIR. It is a case of no injury. A compromise has already been reached between the parties and on the basis of said compromise, a petition bearing CRM-M No.27593 of

2015, for quashing of the FIR has already been filed, wherein, notice of motion has been issued by this Court. The petitioner is a student and pursuing engineering course. He is not involved in any other FIR.

On the other hand, the learned State counsel, on instructions, submits that the presence of the petitioner at the place of occurrence is fully established. He is involved in another case under the NDPS Act. Challan has already been filed against the petitioner.

Heard.

The petitioner is not named in the FIR. None sustained injury in the incident. A compromise has already been reached between the parties. The petitioner being a student, keeping him in custody in the formative years of his life would certainly affect his career and future. The challan has already been filed and the trial is not likely to be concluded in the near future.

In view of the above, without adverting to the merits of the instant case, this petition is allowed. The petitioner be admitted to bail during the pendency of the trial, subject to his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds, to the satisfaction of the trial Court.
