This petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case F.I.R. No.88 dated 2.7.2014 registered under Section 324, 323, 148, 149 IPC (Sections 308 & 326 IPC added later on) at Police Station Bhindi Saidan, District Amritsar Rural.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has relied upon the order dated 11.11.2014 passed in CRM-M-36444-2014 in the case of co-accused- Gian Singh, whereby he was granted the concession of anticipatory bail and further states that facts of the present case are covered by that case.

On instructions from the investigating officer, the learned

Assistant Advocate General accepts that the facts of the present case are covered by that case.

In view of the facts and circumstances of the case, without going into the merits of the case, I deem it appropriate to grant the concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

Resultantly, the petition is allowed.

In the event of arrest of the petitioner, he shall be released on bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating Officer subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
