Prayer is under Section 438 Cr.PC for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner Amarjit Singh in case FIR No.133 dated 21.05.2014 under Sections 328 & 380 of Indian Penal Code registered with Police Station Basti Jodhewal, Ludhiana.

As per allegations, the petitioner is the alleged paramour of the wife of the complainant i.e. Kulwinder Kaur, co-accused. In the FIR lodged after 2-1/2 years, it is alleged that the wife Kulwinder Kaur along with her sister-Varinder Kaur and present petitioner administered some intoxicating material in his tea and during unconscious state stole a bag containing five lac rupees and three tollas of gold.

It is contended that due to the matrimonial dispute the wife-

Kulwinder Kaur left her husband-complainant and the petitioner has been falsely implicated.

Learned State Counsel on instructions from ASI Hardip Singh states that pursuant to the interim order passed by this court petitioner has joined the investigation. However, recoveries are yet to be effected.

In view of the above, interim protection/bail granted vide order dated 25.09.2014 is made absolute.

Petition stands disposed of.
