AJAY TEWARI, J. (Oral)

This petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case F.I.R. No.265 dated 06.05.2015 registered under Sections 419/420/467/468/471/120-B IPC at Police Station Ratia, District Fatehabad.

The allegations are that the petitioner in connivance with the other persons had defrauded the complainant by impersonating the co-accused Kamla Devi.

Learned Additional Sessions Judge has noticed that co-accused Kamla Devi had mentioned that her son Vinod Kumar was the main accused and has dismissed the application for anticipatory bail on this ground. I see no reason to take a different view.

Petition is dismissed.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
