AJAY TEWARI, J. (Oral)

This is a petition for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in FIR No.82 dated 12.08.2014 registered under Sections 457/380/413 of IPC at Police Station City Budhlada, District Mansa (Punjab).

Learned counsel for the petitioners has argued that the petitioners were released on bail on 30.03.2015 and thereafter regularly appeared for four dates but could not appear on 03.07.2015 and then their bail bonds were cancelled.

Learned counsel for the petitioners has argued that the petitioners had been regularly appearing and missed the hearing only on one

day.

In my considered opinion, it would be appropriate to direct the petitioners to appear before the trial Court on the next date and, in case the assertion regarding the previous appearances is correct, the petitioners would be released on bail to the satisfaction of the trial Court.

Petition stands disposed of.
