Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.10 dated 04.02.2015, under Sections 302, 323, 342, 367, 427, 148, 149 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 and Sections 3 and 4 of the Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, 1989, registered at Police Station Sekhwan, District Gurdaspur.

Following order was passed by this Court on 05.10.2015:-

“Learned counsel for the petitioner requests for an adjournment.

List again on 8.12.2015.

In the meantime, petitioner is directed to surrender before the Trial Court and the Trial Court shall release the petitioner on interim bail subject to its satisfaction.”
