Having absented on July 3, 2015, bail bonds of the petitioners were cancelled.

Counsel for the petitioner submits that on the said date the petitioners could not appear before the Court as they were out of station on account of some religious ceremony. Counsel for the petitioners submits that an application for exemption from personal appearance was filed on the same day but it was dismissed by the Sessions Judge on account of the fact that the petitioners had already been marked absent prior to the lunch hours and the Presiding Officer did not hold the Court after lunch.

Without entering into the controversy regarding the cause of non-appearance on the date of hearing i.e. July 3, 2015, in the interest of justice and expeditious disposal of the case, I deem it appropriate to dispose of this petition by giving an opportunity to the petitioners to appear on the next date of hearing.

This petition is disposed of in limine. It is ordered that the petitioners will put in appearance before the trial Court on the next date of hearing which is stated to be September 25, 2015 and in case of their doing so, they will be released on bail on their furnishing fresh bail bonds with surety bonds to the satisfaction of the said Court.
