Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 seeking regular bail in FIR No.69 dated 16.09.2014, under Sections 307, 341, 506, 34 of Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station Ghanie Ke Bangar, District Gurdaspur.

Prosecution story, in brief, is that the petitioner and his co-accused had given fist and kick blows in the abdomen as well as testicles of Ranjit Singh. Petitioner was allegedly having an iron grip/punch.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that as per the medico-legal report, injured had complained of pain in abdomen but no external mark of injury was seen. No injury was opined to have been suffered by the injured on his testicles. Petitioner is in custody since 13.11.2014

and conclusion of trial may take time.

Learned State counsel, on the other hand has opposed the petition and has submitted that the injury in the abdomen of the injured was with blunt weapon and was declared dangerous to life.

Keeping in view the submissions made by learned counsel for the petitioner, it would be just and expedient to order the release of the petitioner on bail.

Accordingly, without expressing any opinion on merits on the case, this petition is allowed. Petitioner be admitted to bail, subject to the satisfaction of the Chief Judicial Magistrate, Gurdaspur.
