Petitioners claimed that the matter has been compromised.

Learned counsel for respondent No.2-complainant has put in appearance to state that the matter has actually been compromised.

On the instructions of ASI Avneet Singh, it has been informed that the challan has not yet been presented and cancellation report has been prepared.

Learned counsel for the complainant has submitted that statement has already been recorded by the investigating officer.

In view of the matter having been compromised and cancellation report having been prepared, this petition is disposed of with a direction that the supplementary statement of the complainant may be recorded by the investigating officer within a period of one month and take

necessary action in accordance with law including submission of cancellation report. In case cancellation report is submitted, complainant Simranpreet Kaur would furnish her no objection. In said eventuality, the Illaqa Magistrate shall accept cancellation/untraced report. It is made clear that in case supplementary statement has been recorded, the State authority shall ensure to take a decision on the cancellation report within a period of one month.
