Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of order dated 22.09.2014 passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation. It is further stated that earlier this case was referred to Mediation and Conciliation Center of this Court but settlement could not be arrived at between the parties.

On perusal of the allegations as well as the contentions of learned counsel for the petitioner, it appears that it is a case of second marriage of both the parties and both of them are having children from the earlier marriage. The allegations levelled in the FIR are the matter of evidence which can be seen during trial and nothing can be said at this stage. Since the petitioner has joined investigation, the interim order dated 22.09.2014 passed by this Court is made absolute.

Petition stands disposed of.
