The petitioners apprehending threat to their life and liberty at the hands of official respondents at the instance of private respondents have prayed that a direction for protection of their life and liberty be issued.

On instructions of S.I. Balbir Singh, it has been informed by the State counsel that the petitioners are not accused in any case and are not required for any purpose.

On asking of the Court, it has been informed that no complaint has been filed by respondents No.6 and 7. No complainant of Gurdev Singh and Parminder Singh is pending against the petitioners.

In view of the said information supplied, this petition has rendered infructuous and accordingly the same is disposed of as having rendered infructuous. However, it is ordered that in case the petitioners are required by the police on the basis of any complaint filed by Gurdev Singh and Parminder Singh, they will be given a notice of 7 days to enable them to avail the legal remedy available to them. This order will remain operative only for a period of one year and would be applicable only in the circumstances mentioned here-in-above.
