SHEKHER DHAWAN, J.

Present petition for anticipatory bail under Section 438 of Code of Criminal Procedure in case FIR No.489 dated 07.09.2015, Police Station Sector 5, Gurgaon, under Sections 354(A)(1), 341, 323, 506, 509 IPC.

Relevant facts of the case that on 06.08.2015 complainant Jeewanlata was coming back from market on a rickshaw and at that time present petitioner reached there who was on a motorcycle along with one more person. They obstructed the way and the rickshaw was about to turn turtle. Present petitioner caught hold of complainant from her hand and pulled down from the rickshaw and threatened to withdraw the FIR and stop going to the Court otherwise she and her family would be killed. She resisted to that and petitioner started abusing her and also tried to tear her clothes. Her sister tried to save her and petitioner gave push to her and also threatened that if she wants her honour and life, payment of Rs.10,00,000/- be made failing which her life would be ruined.

Learned counsel for petitioner mainly submitted that there is delay of 30 hours in reporting the matter. Petitioner is ready to join the

investigation. So he be released on bail.

Learned State counsel submitted that petitioner is habitual offender and there are other cases on the basis of private complaints against him. He has committed heinous crime and his custodial interrogation is required. So the petition for anticipatory bail be dismissed.

Having considered the rival contentions that petitioner is required for the purpose of custodial interrogation and there are specific allegation against the petitioner for assault with an intention to disrobe a woman. No case is made out for release of petitioner on anticipatory bail and present petition stands dismissed.
