INDERJIT SINGH, J.

Petitioners have filed the present petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C., seeking anticipatory bail in case FIR No.226 dated 14.12.2014, registered at Police Station Navi Baradari, District Jalandhar, under Sections 406, 420 IPC.

Notice of motion was issued. Learned State counsel appeared and contested this petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioners and learned State counsel and have gone through the record.

First of all, the petitioners have already joined the investigation and they are not required for custodial interrogation nor anything is to be recovered from them. Otherwise also, as per FIR, the dispute is regarding execution of the sale deed on the basis of agreement to sell and there is allegation that amount of Rs.5,00,000/- of the complainant has been usurped by the petitioner. No useful purpose will be served by sending the petitioners to custody.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the case and without discussing the facts of the case in minute details and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and the order dated 30.01.2015, passed by this Court, granting interim bail to the petitioners is made absolute.
