Instant petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.33 dated 27.12.2012, registered at Police Station State Vigilance Bureau, Rohtak, under Sections 409, 420 and 120-B of the Indian Penal Code.

Heard learned counsel for the parties.

Vide order dated 06.02.2015, a Coordinate Bench of this Court directed that in the event of arrest, the petitioner would be released

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on interim bail to the satisfaction of SHO/Investigating Officer in connection with above-said case FIR.

There are allegations against the petitioner that she while performing the duty as Sarpanch, had allegedly misappropriated the amount. Earlier, the matter was investigated by the Inspector, Vigilance and it was found that there was no fault on the part of the petitioner except some irregularities and no criminal offence regarding misappropriation of panchayat funds is made out. Now, the investigation has been carried out by the Sh.Ram Bhaj, DSP, State Vigilance Bureau, Rohtak. On instructions from DSP present in Court, learned State counsel informs that the petitioner has joined the investigation. Learned State counsel further states that nothing is to be recovered from the petitioner and her custodial interrogation is not required.

Having considered the facts and circumstances of the case, order dated 06.02.2015 passed by a Coordinate Bench of this Court is made absolute.

Present petition is disposed of accordingly.
