AJAY TEWARI, J. (Oral)

This petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case F.I.R. No.66 dated 03.03.2014 registered under Sections 342, 304-A, 304, 377 IPC at Police Station Agroha, District Hisar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has argued that the petitioner has been in custody since 05.03.2014.

Learned Deputy Advocate General have accepted these factual assertions but states that only two witnesses remained to be examined and the next date is 14.10.2015.

I find this to be a fair submission. In the circumstances, in view of the undertaking given by the learned Deputy Advocate General, it is directed that in case the prosecution does not lead its entire evidence on or before 14.10.2015 (subject to the petitioner not obstructing the same) he be released on bail to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.

Ordered accordingly.

Petition stands disposed of.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
