Prayer is under Section 438 Cr.PC for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner Bhim Sain in case FIR No.160 dated 20.08.2015 for offences punishable under Sections 323, 324, 326, 341, 148, 149, 506 of Indian Penal Code registered with Police Station Ding, District Sirsa.

As per allegations the petitioner is alleged to have inflicted blows on the elbow and leg of complainant Ami Lal with his *kappa*.

It is contended from the FIR it is apparent that the dispute was regarding directing animals towards the village of the accused. It is further contended that the aforesaid injuries have been opined to be simple in nature and allegation for the offence under Section 506 IPC have been falsely introduced to make the offence non bailable.

Learned Counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to the interim order passed by this court petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Ran Singh submits that pursuant to the interim order passed by this court petitioner has joined the investigation and is no longer required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, interim protection/pre-arrest bail granted vide order dated 24th of September, 2015 is made absolute.

Petition stands disposed of.
