Report dated 03.10.2015 sent by learned Sub-Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Samrala has been received, whereby, after recording statements of petitioner Gurjeet Singh as well as of complainant Kulwant Singh it has been informed that the parties have effected a compromise voluntarily on their free will and accord without any pressure.

Keeping in view that the parties have effected a compromise which will go a long way to sort out the differences between them and in view of law laid down in **Gian Singh vs. State of Punjab and another 2012(4) RCR Criminal 543** and **Kulwinder Singh and others vs. State of Punjab and another 2007(3) RCR Criminal 1052,** FIR No.128 dated 02.06.2015 under Sections 420,406,506 IPC Police Station, Samrala, District Ludhiana and all other consequential

proceedings arising therefrom are hereby quashed qua the present petitioner.
