Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.129 dated 3.11.2012 under Section 363-A and 366 IPC registered at Police Station Nangal, District Ropar.

This Court vide order dated 28.9.2015 while issuing notice of motion has granted interim bail to the petitioner subject to his joining investigation and complying the provisions of Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that pursuant to order dated 28.9.2015, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Kashmir Singh,

submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and the custodial interrogation of the petitioner is not required at this stage.

In view of the above, the instant petition is allowed and the interim bail granted by this Court to the petitioner vide order dated 28.9.2015 is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall continue to join investigation as and when required to do so and shall abide by the terms and conditions, as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
