1. Whether Reporters of local papers may be allowed to see the judgment?

AJAY TEWARI, J. (Oral)

This petition has been filed under Section 439(2) Cr.P.C. read with Section 482 Cr.P.C. for cancellation of the pre-arrest bail granted to respondents No.4 and 5 by the Additional Sessions Court, Jalandhar in FIR No.08 dated 05.02.2015 registered under Sections 406 and 498-A IPC at Police Station Women Cell, Jalandhar.

After arguing for some time, learned counsel states that he does not wish to press this petition on merits but in this connection the petitioner has also moved representation dated 10.08.2015 (Annexure P-4) to the respondent No.2-The Commissioner of Police, Jalandhar with the prayer

that investigation of the said FIR be transferred to some senior police officer and at this stage she would be satisfied if a direction is given to respondent No.2 to look into the matter and decide her representation within any reasonable time.

I find this to be a fair request. The respondent No.2 is directed to look into the matter/representation (Annexure P-4) and take whatever action he deems necessary as per law.

Petition stands disposed of in the above terms.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
