Petitioners seek pre-arrest bail in FIR No.119 dated 11.8.2015 registered under Sections 452, 324, 323 and 34 IPC (Section 326 IPC was added later on) at Police Station Kulgarhi, District Ferozepur.

Notice of motion was issued and interim protection was granted to the petitioners.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from HC Jagtar Singh, Police Station Kulgarhi, submits that in compliance of the order passed by this Court, petitioners have joined the investigation and also cooperated with the investigating agency, because of which, they are no more required for any further investigation.

However, learned counsel for the complainant opposes the present petition, contending that petitioners are trying to back out from the compromise (Annexure P-4). He prays for dismissal of the present petition.

After hearing the learned counsel for the parties, going through the record of the case and without commenting anything further on merits at this stage, lest it should prejudice the case of either side at a later point of time, petitioners have been found entitled for the concession of anticipatory bail. Leaving the scope of amicable settlement between the parties open, the present petition is allowed. The order dated 24.9.2015 passed by this Court is hereby made absolute, however, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.

Disposed of, accordingly.
