The instant petition has been preferred under Section 439 Cr.P.C. seeking regular bail in case FIR No.23 dated 14.05.2015, registered under Sections 326, 324, 452, 148, 149 of the Indian Penal Code, at Police Station Khalra, Distt. Tarn Taran.

The learned counsel for the petitioner contends that it is a case of version and cross-version. He refers to Annexure P-1, the MLR, and stated that the petitioner also suffered injuries. The petitioner is in custody since 20.06.2015. All the co-accused, except, Nirvail Singh, have been granted bail by this Court.

The learned State counsel states that the challan has been

filed, however, the charges are yet to be framed.

Heard.

As per the medico-legal report of the petitioner, Annexure P-1 and the X-ray report, Annexure P-2, injury No.1 sustained by the petitioner has been declared as grievous in nature. The petitioner is in custody since 20.06.2015. Though, the challan has already been presented, but the charges are yet to be framed. As per the custody certificate dated 03.10.2015, filed in the Court, the petitioner is not involved in any other FIR. The co-accused, except Nirvail Singh, are already on bail.

In view of the above, without adverting to the merits of the instant case, this petition is allowed. The petitioner be admitted to bail during the pendency of the trial, subject to his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds, to the satisfaction of the trial Court.
