The prayer is for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.183 dated 10.09.2015, under Sections 452, 324, 323, 506, 148 and 149 of the Indian Penal Code, registered with Police Station City Ferozepur, District Ferozepur.

At the time of hearing, learned Counsel for the petitioner/accused submits that the present petition has become infructuous in the light of the petitioner/accused having been acquitted of the charges on the basis of a compromise.
