This is a petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. seeking regular bail in a case registered under Sections 22/61/85 of NDPS Act vide FIR No. 130 dated 20.7.2014 at Police Station, Bahaw Wala, District Fazilka.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from HC-Kewal Singh, submits that trial is nearing its culmination as only one prosecution witness remains to be examined.

In view of above, no ground is made out for enlarging the petitioner on bail.

Dismissed.
