The petitioner seeks quashing of FIR No.4 dated 03.01.2013 under Sections 381 and 411 IPC, registered at Police Station Manimajra, Chandigarh and all subsequent proceedings emanating therefrom on the basis of compromise.

The FIR was registered at the instance of respondent No.2- Vishal Sharma alleging that the petitioner, being an employee of the complainant, committed theft of some shoes which have been recorded in the CCTV footage.

Parties were directed to appear before the Illaqa Magistrate to get their statement recorded regarding the matter having been compromised voluntarily. After recording the statements of the parties, a report has been received to the effect that the parties have amicably compromised the matter without any threat, coercion or inducement.

In view of the judgment in ***Kulwinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab, 2007(3) RCR (Crl.) 1052***, the petition is allowed. The aforesaid FIR and all the subsequent proceedings emanating therefrom, are hereby quashed on the basis of compromise subject to the petitioner depositing a total sum of Rs.5,000/- with State Legal Services Authority Fund, U.T. within a period of one month.
