By filing the present petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, the petitioners have sought anticipatory bail in case FIR No.459, dated 11.07.2015, registered under Sections 498-A, 494, 323, 506 and 34 IPC, at Police Station Sadar Karnal, District Karnal.

It is contended that the petitioners are in laws of the complainant. In pursuance of the order dated 24.09.2015, the petitioners have joined the investigation.

The learned State counsel, on instructions, submits that the petitioners have joined the investigation and they are not required

for custodial interrogation.

The learned counsel for the complainant states that she is receiving threatening calls from the son of the petitioners who is serving as constable in the Punjab Police. The learned State counsel ensures that all necessary steps shall be taken to provide safety and security to the complainant.

In view of the above, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the interim bail granted by this Court vide order dated 24.09.2015, is made absolute, subject to the conditions contained in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

The petition stands allowed.
