Petitioner has preferred this petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of direction to respondent Nos.1 to 3 to protect her life and liberty and to provide police protection to her and further issuance of direction to respondent Nos.3 to 7 or anybody else not to interfere in the life and liberty of the petitioner and her parents.

Learned counsel for the petitioner only prays for the relief that the representation dated 15.09.2015 (Annexure P-1), given to Senior Superintendent of Police, Hoshiarpur, by the petitioner, be considered and he does not press the other relief asked in this petition.

In view of above, Respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Hoshiarpur is directed to look into the said representation (Annexure P-1); take appropriate action as per law and pass appropriate order, without being influenced in any way by this order, within two months from the date of receipt of copy of this order.

With aforesaid direction, this petition stands disposed of.
