Report dated 07.10.2015 sent by learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Moga has been received, whereby, after recording statements of petitioners Shingara Singh, Kulwant Singh and Jasvir Singh as well as of complainant Gurmail Singh, it has been informed that the parties have effected a compromise voluntarily on their free will and accord without any pressure.

Keeping in view that it is case of version and cross-version and that parties have effected a compromise which will go a long way to sort out the differences between them and in view of law laid down in **Gian Singh vs. State of Punjab and another 2012(4) RCR Criminal 543** and **Kulwinder Singh and others vs. State of Punjab and another 2007(3) RCR Criminal 1052**, FIR No.151 dated 09.11.2010 under Sections 323,324,34,IPC, Police Station, Moga Sadar, District Moga and all other consequential proceedings arising therefrom

are hereby quashed qua the present petitioners.

Petition stands disposed off.
