JASWANT SINGH, J. (Oral)

The prayer is for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No. 32 dated 22.01.2015, under Sections 420, 468, 467, 471, 511 of the Indian Penal Code, registered with Police Station Sadar, Sirsa (**Annexure P-1**).

As per allegations surfacing in the investigation, the petitioner/accused was the mastermind of misusing a cheque and fraudulently tried to withdraw Rs.4 Crores from Punjab National Bank.

Learned Counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is in custody since 20.08.2015 and investigations qua him are over. She further submits that the matter is triable by the Magistrate.

Learned State Counsel, on instructions from SI Ram Kumar, concedes regarding the custody period and the investigations qua him are over.

Without commenting on the merits of the case, keeping in view the custody period, the case is triable by the Magistrate and the investigations qua the petitioner are over, this Court finds that petitioner/accused deserves the concession of regular bail and as such he is ordered to be released on bail to the satisfaction of CJM/Duty Magistrate, Sirsa.
