AJAY TEWARI, J. (Oral)

This is a petition for regular bail filed in case bearing FIR No.190 dated 05.12.2014, under section 22/61/85 of NDPS Act, 1985, registered at Police Station Mukerian, District Hoshiarpur.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has argued that by order dated 09.07.2015 this Court had dismissed the previous application while directing the trial Court to expedite the trial but despite that no evidence has been led. Learned AAG, on instructions from H.C. Ravinder Singh, has stated that three witnesses remain to be examined and the prosecution undertakes to conclude its entire evidence by 30.11.2015 subject to the petitioner not obstructing the same.

Resultantly it is directed that in case the prosecution does not conclude its entire evidence by 30.11.2015(subject to the petitioner not

obstructing the same), the trial Court shall release the petitioner on bail to its satisfaction.

Petition stands disposed of.

Since the main case has been decided, the Criminal Misc. Application, if any, also stands disposed of.
