Instant petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No. 417, dated 23.08.2014 under Sections 498-A/406/34 IPC (Section 376 and Section 411 IPC added later) registered at Police Station Civil Lines, Rohtak.

Heard learned counsel for the parties.

Vide order dated 23.09.2014, this Court directed that in the event of arrest, the petitioner would be released on interim bail to the satisfaction of the Arresting/Investigating Officer in connection with above-said case FIR.

On instructions from ASI Anil Kumar, Police Station Civil Lines, Rohtak learned State counsel informs that the petitioner has joined the investigation. Learned State counsel further states that nothing

is to be recovered from the petitioner and his custodial interrogation is not required.

Having considered the facts and circumstances of the case, order dated 23.09.2014 passed by this Court is made absolute.

Present petition is disposed of accordingly.
