This petition has been filed by petitioner Gaurav under Section 438 Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 (hereinafter called Cr.P.C) for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No. 76 dated 25.07.2014, under Sections 406, 498-A, 313 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 (hereinafter called IPC), registered at Police Station City Fazilka, District Fazilka.

During the pendency of the present petition, the mediation proceedings were conducted at Fazilka and the matter has been settled amicable between the parties.

Learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned counsel for the complainant have stated in one voice that now the petitioner and complainant Alish are living jointly and their matrimonial life is running smoothly.

Learned counsel for the complainant stated that he has no objection if the order of interim anticipatory bail dated 23.09.2014 is made absolute.
