Petitioners have filed this petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.62 dated 06.05.2014, under Sections 457, 307, 148, 149 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 ('IPC' for short) (Sections 182, 195, 211, 120-B IPC added later on) and Section 25, 27 of the Arms Act, 1959, registered at Police Station Baghapurana.

In the present case, admittedly, offences under Sections 182, 195, 211, 120-B IPC have been added. Let necessary additions be made in the head note of the petition.

While issuing notice of motion, following order was passed by this Court on 24.09.2014:-

“Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that for the reasons already given by this Court, while granting interim anticipatory bail to the co-accused of the petitioner, who had filed CRM-M-29565-2014, the petitioners would seek party with their co-accused.

He submits that the petitioners would also be treated alike, in view of what this Court, prima facie, has observed, with regard to the fact that the first

petitioner in CRM-M-29565-2014, i.e. Roop Singh, was himself shot in the chest, but, on the other hand, there are no injuries on the complainant side whatsoever.

Notice of motion be issued to the respondents, returnable on 14.10.2014.

To be heard along with CRM-M-29565-2014.

Interim order in the same terms."

Learned State counsel who is assisted by Inspector Partap Singh has submitted that petitioners have joined investigation and are not required for further investigation.

Accordingly, interim bail granted to the petitioners by this Court vide order dated 24.09.2014, is made absolute.

Petition stands disposed of accordingly.
