JASWANT SINGH, J (ORAL)

Prayer is under Section 438 Cr.PC for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners namely Daljit Singh & Baljinder Singh in case FIR No.85 dated 30.08.2015 for offences punishable under Sections 392, 506, 148, 149 of Indian Penal Code and Section 25 of the Arms Act registered with Police Station Kathu Nangal, District Amritsar Rural.

As per allegations levelled by the complainant Baldev Singh he and his brother Iqbal Singh had purchased Innova Car from Gurmej Singh after making a payment of Rs.7.50 lacs. Petitioner no.1 Daljit Singh is the person who had sold Innova Car to Gurmej Singh and was yet to receive the payment of Rs.8 lacs. It is further alleged that at the time of occurrence

Gurmej Singh, his son Money and the petitioner and one Baljinder Singh along with three other unidentified person had intercepted the Innova Car and thereafter by pointing gun towards complainant took away the Car.

It is contended that the petitioner himself is a victim since he is yet to receive the sale price of Rs.8 lacs apart from the fact that the main role has been attributed to Gurmej Singh and his son.

Learned Counsel for the petitioners submits that pursuant to the interim order passed by this court petitioners have joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Ajit Singh submits that pursuant to the interim order passed by this court petitioners have joined the investigation and are no longer required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, interim protection/pre-arrest bail granted vide order dated 28th of September, 2015 is made absolute.

Petition stands disposed of.
