Report dated 08.12.2015 sent by learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Kapurthala has been received, whereby, after recording statements of petitioner Pulkit Murgai as well as of complainant Ravi Kumar it has been informed that the parties have effected a compromise voluntarily on their free will and accord without any pressure.

Keeping in view that the parties have effected a compromise which will go a long way to sort out the differences between them and in view of law laid down in **Gian Singh vs. State of Punjab and another 2012(4) RCR Criminal 543** and **Kulwinder Singh and others vs. State of Punjab and another 2007(3) RCR Criminal 1052,** FIR No.156 dated 20.06.2015 under Sections 295A and 34 IPC Police Station, Kapurthala City and all other consequential proceedings arising therefrom are hereby quashed qua the present petitioner.
