Petitioners seek quashing of FIR No.164 dated 13.11.2009, under Sections 406, 498-A IPC registered at Police Station Division No.3, District Jalandhar on the basis of compromise.

The said FIR was registered at the instance of respondent No.2 Meenu alleging that she was married to petitioner No.1 on 20.02.2002. She had been maltreated by petitioner No.1 and his family members.

Parties have got their statements before the Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Jalandhar. A report has been received to the effect that the matter has been compromised voluntarily. Parties appear to have filed a petition under Section 13-B of the Hindu Marriage Act for dissolution of marriage.

On the basis of report of the Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Jalandhar, I am satisfied that the matrimonial dispute between the parties

has been finally resolved. Parties have decided to part company by filing a petition under Section 13-B of the Hindu Marriage Act. Certain terms and conditions of the compromise are to be complied with by the parties.

In view of said circumstances, the petition is allowed. The said FIR and all the criminal proceedings emanating therefrom are hereby quashed on the basis of compromise subject to the condition that the parties will adhere to the terms of the settlement entered into between the parties. In case of violation of any of the condition, it will be open to the parties to approach this Court for recalling the order.
