By filing the present petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, the petitioners have sought anticipatory bail in a complaint case No. 19 dated 04.06.2010, under Sections 323, 325, 34 IPC and Section 3(i)(x) of the Scheduled Castes & Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, 1989.

The learned counsel for the petitioner states that in pursuance of the order dated 30.09.2014, the petitioners have appeared and furnished bail/surety bonds before the trial Court. This fact has been duly acknowledged by learned counsel for the respondent.

In view of the above, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the interim bail granted by this Court vide order dated 30.09.2014, is made absolute.
