SABINA, J.

Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.179 dated 12.08.2013, under Sections 307, 452, 506 and 427 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 and Section 25/27/54/59 of Arms Act, registered at Police Station Beas, District Amritsar.

On 26.09.2014, the following order was passed by this Court:-

“Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that it is a case of no injury.

Notice of motion for 05.12.2014.

In the meantime, in the event of arrest, petitioner be admitted to interim bail subject to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer. He shall abide by the conditions envisaged under Section 438 (2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973.”

Learned State counsel, who is assisted by Head Constable Baljinder Singh, has submitted that the petitioner has not joined the investigation as he is involved in another criminal case also.

Since the petitioner has failed to join the investigation in terms of order dated 26.09.2014, this petition is liable to be dismissed.

Accordingly, this petition is dismissed.
