RITU BAHRI, J.

This petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C is for quashing of FIR No.35 dated 26.05.2013, under Sections 447, 427, 511, 506, 323, 148, 149 IPC, registered at Police Station, Sadar Bathinda, District Bathinda.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from HC Gamdoor Singh, has informed the Court that after presentation of the challan, charges against the petitioners have been framed on 11.03.2014. There are 10 prosecution witnesses, out of which, none has been examined as of today.

At this stage, this petition is disposed of by giving liberty to the petitioners to take all the pleas before the trial Court. However, keeping in view that there are only 10 prosecution witnesses to be examined, the trial Court is directed to conclude the trial expeditiously.
