Petitioners have filed this petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.162 dated 18.08.2015, under Sections 295-A/427 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 read with Section 3(1) (10) of the Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, 1989, registered at Police Station City Rupnagar.

Following order was passed by this Court on
06.10.2015:-

“Learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that civil litigation was pending between the parties. No offence under the Scheduled Caste and Scheduled Tribe (Prevention

of Atrocities) Act, 1989 can be said to have been committed by the petitioners.

List again on 10.12.2015.

In the meantime, in the event of arrest, petitioners be admitted to interim bail subject to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer. Petitioners shall abide by the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973."

Learned State counsel who is assisted by Head Constable Suresh Kumar has submitted that the petitioners have joined investigation and are not required for further investigation.

Accordingly, interim bail granted to the petitioners by this Court vide order dated 06.10.2015, is made absolute.

Petition stands disposed of accordingly.
