This is a petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. seeking regular bail in a case registered against the petitioner under Sections 147, 148, 149, 323, 324, 307, 186, 332, 353, 506 IPC at Police Station Chandhut, District Palwal, vide FIR No.192 dated 18.06.2015.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the injured policeman did not suffer any injury attracting offence under section 307 IPC and though investigation is complete, no prosecution witness has been examined. Petitioner is in custody since 6.7.2015. Trial would, thus, take long time to conclude.

Learned State counsel (on instructions from ASI Suresh Kumar, who is present in court) has opposed the prayer. According to him, there are serious allegations against the petitioner.
