Learned counsel for the petitioner seeks quashing of order dated 25.11.2013 passed by learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Kurukshetra (Annexure P-1) as well as order dated 21.1.2015 passed by Addl. Sessions Judge, Kurukshetra (Annexure P-2), vide which interim maintenance @ Rs. 6000/- per month to the divorced wife had been allowed. There are concurrent findings of two courts below, I do not find any ground to interfere in the order granting interim maintenance to the wife.

Accordingly, the petition stands dismissed.

However, trial Court is directed to comply with the directions of the Id. Addl. Sessions Judge, Kurukshetra to dispose of the petition preferably within two months.
