Report dated 15.10.2015 sent by learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Amritsar has been received, whereby, after recording statement of petitioner Raj Kumar @ Rinku as well as of complainant Harbhajan Singh it has been informed that the parties have effected a compromise voluntarily on their free will and accord without any pressure.

Keeping in view that it is pure matrimonial dispute and that the parties have effected a compromise which will go a long way to settle their future lives and in view of law laid down in **Gian Singh vs. State of Punjab and another 2012(4) RCR Criminal 543** and **Kulwinder Singh and others vs. State of Punjab and another 2007(3) RCR Criminal 1052**, FIR No.242 dated 06.08.2014 under Sections 420,467,468,471,120-B IPC, Police Station, Jandiala Guru, Amritsar and all other consequential proceedings arising therefrom are

hereby quashed qua the present petitioner.
