Petitioner seeks issuance of directions to release the petitioner on bail in the event of his arrest/appearance in case FIR No. 4 dated 8.1.2015 registered under Sections 406, 420 and 120-B IPC at Police Station Bhogpur, District Jalandhar.

Notice of motion was issued.

Learned counsel for respondent No.3 as well as learned counsel for the State submit that after passing of the order dated 29.7.2015, dismissing the earlier petition for anticipatory bail of the petitioner, parties have arrived at an amicable settlement.

In view of the above-said undisputed position, instant petition is allowed and in the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be released on anticipatory bail to the satisfaction of arresting/investigating officer subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C. At the first instance, petitioner shall join the investigation on or before 23.12.2015 and cooperate with the investigating agency. The petitioner is also directed to join the investigation, thereafter, as and when required by the investigating agency, by issuing a notice under Section 160 Cr.P.C.

Disposed of, accordingly.
