Feeling aggrieved against the alleged inaction on the part of respondent authorities, petitioner has approached this Court, by way of instant petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C., seeking appropriate directions.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that when the genuine grievance of the petitioner was not being redressed, he approached respondent No.5, by way of representation dated 18.09.2015 (Annexure P-9) but the same is also pending. She further submits that petitioner will be satisfied in case respondent No.5 is directed to consider the grievance of the petitioner within reasonable time.

Having heard the learned counsel for the petitioner and without expressing any opinion on the merits, lest it should prejudice the rights of either of the parties, Inspector General of Police, Railway Police, Moginand, District Panchkula is directed to look into the matter, consider the grievance of the petitioner raised in his representation dated 18.09.2015 (Annexure P-9)

and decide the same at an early date, by passing an appropriate order strictly, in accordance with law but in any case within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

With the abovesaid observations made and directions issued, present petition stands disposed of.
